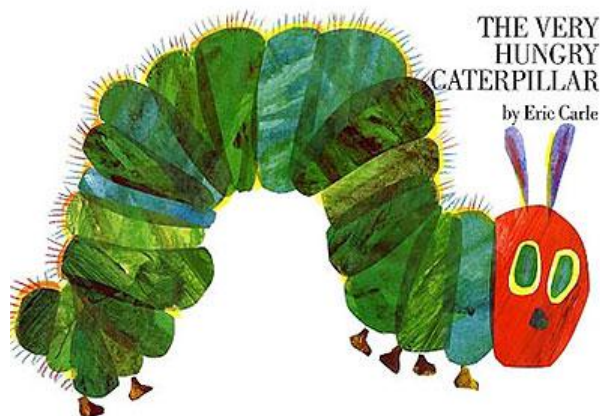


Celebrate The Very Hungry Caterpillar
