I am formally writing a request for approval from both you and the City Council, to be able to host our 4 Year Anniversary Event Outside at Wake Brewing. I have attached details below on the event being requested for approval. I am hoping we can present this to the City Council for the August 9th agenda.

Date - Friday September 10 and Saturday September 11 2021

Time - Friday 5:00pm - 10:00pm / Saturday 2:00 pm - 10:00 pm

Location - Wake Brewing

Parking - Across the street at the QCCA Expo Center - Permission already granted by owner.

Security - I will have two security guards, one at the entrance gate checking all IDs and one walking around making sure everyone is behaving.

Bands - I have a couple bands in the Rock genre playing from 2:00 - 10:00pm I am aware of the db restrictions and the sound company knows to not exceed them. Also I will have attached the sound amplification permit as well in the next few days of this request. Music will be done no later than 10pm each night to take into consideration our neighbors.

Food is being provided by Lopies Pizza, Smash, and Floyds Burgers - they will coordinate with Brian Taulke to make sure they are up to code and have any licenses they might need.

I am also requesting permission to have one outside POS not to exceed a 10x10 area for beers and water to be served, this will be located within our fence line of Wake Brewing and will ensure we keep capacity under control inside our establishment. This event is strictly a 21+ event and we will have security checking ID's.

This will be an amazing showing of a Rock Island business celebrating their fourth successful year being opened - all local media will be contacted and all on board to do coverage of the event. The grand opening saw over 1000 people throughout the day. I know we will at least see that if not more.

We both the City and myself have a vested interest in making this event a huge success, I appreciate everything the City has done for me to get this far. I am open to anything it takes to get this approved by the council, just let me know. With everything we all have been through this past year, this is a great way for us to celebrate still being here and still being Rock Island strong.
