Attached to this memorandum is a resolution declaring the City of Rock Island's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds for Phase I Engineering of the CRI Job 2831; 30th Street Resurfacing/Reconstruction from 5th Avenue to 18th Avenue.

Per memo 2022-046 approved by City Council on the March 14, 2022 meeting, the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department was granted approval to begin working with the consultant, Hutchison Engineering, Inc.

Phase I Engineering of this project is being funded by the City of Rock Island's Motor Fuel Tax allotment. As such, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) requires that this bureau of local roads form (BLR 09110) be filed in order to proceed with typical authorizations granted during the Phase I Engineering process.

The Resolution for Improvement Under the Illinois Highway Code form (BLR 09110) requires the signature and seal of the City Clerk. A resolution from the City of Rock Island as the local public agency authorizing the use of funds from the Motor Fuel Tax funds allotment is therefore required.

Recommendation

The Public Works Department recommends that the City Council approve the resolution declaring their acknowledgement and authorization of the City of Rock Island's Motor Fuel Tax funds to be utilized for Phase I Engineering of the CRI Job 2831 – 30th Street Resurfacing/Reconstruction 5th Avenue to 18th Avenue.
