



Special Pickups for Residents Rules and Regulations

DO place all items at your normal collection site by 7:00 AM on the morning of the Special Pickup. Items may be placed at this location up to 48 hours prior to the pickup date. City crews cannot go on private property.

DON'T include appliances (white goods) or tires. Please visit ricwma.org or call 1-877-934-5378 for disposal information.

DON'T include household hazardous waste such as drain openers, oven cleaners, spot removers, paint, paint removers, stains and varnishes, epoxies and adhesives, weed killers, insecticides, etc. Please visit wastecom.com or call 1-563-386-9575 for disposal information.

DON'T include electronic waste such as computers and other electronic devices. Please visit wastecom.com or call 1-563-823-0119 for disposal information.

DON'T include bricks, concrete blocks, masonry, or railroad ties. These items may be taken to Millennium Waste located at 13606 Knoxville Road, south of Milan, on Saturdays between 7:00 AM and 12:00 noon.

DO place small items such as clothes, books, dishes, and toys in a bag, box or a container weighing no more than 50 pounds. Loose items will not be picked up.

DO tie large items such as building lumber and carpet into bundles no longer than 4.5 feet in length and weighing no more than 50 pounds.

DO cut tree limbs and branches into lengths no longer than 4.5 feet in length and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Limbs and branches less than 2 inches in diameter must be tied into bundles with twine or rope and weigh no more than 50 pounds.

The City will not pickup items that do not comply with the rules and regulations or items that may damage equipment.
